What is the PEOPL Process?

philosophical establishments – colleges, universities, churches and large "social justice" organizations such as the ACLU and the Southern Poverty Law Center.

This is bad principle, and the people have been deceived into cooperating.

HERE IS GOOD PRINCIPLE

Good principle is: ask honest and wise people to run for office. Let the many select from the "Long List".

As the late Neil A. Maxwell mentioned: "It is all so much more than going into the little voting booth and being sixty-second citizens... In electoral ecology, there is a greater impact and influence at the front end of the process than in the voting booth, as sacred and special as the latter is." *Insights from My Life*, 1976

Principled, honest and wise men and women should be sought out, instead of settling for representatives whose main agenda is re-election through slick talk, endless promises and influence peddling.

Good principle is to stop voting for the lesser of two evils and to nominate "PEOPL" who will defend freedom and independence at all costs.
